#### Effort

1. Always makes a good effort.

A 6a indicates that a student is working at the higher end of the grade, whereas a 6b indicates work at the lower end of the grade range. Students should aim to work at a Grade 7, with an effort of 1 or 2 in all subjects.

**The 9-1 Grade reflects the grade that they are expected to achieve at GCSE in Year 11, rather than the grade they are currently working at.**

- End of Year Assessments will take place during the two week period 3<sup>rd</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> June.
