Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that hockey training sessions will begin the week after half term. The training nights will take place at Polo Farm and the days and times will be as follows:

**Monday nights**

Year 10 and seniors training - 4.30-6pm (first session 29<sup>th</sup> October)

**Thursday Nights**

Year 7, 8 and 9 training - 4.30pm -6pm (first session 1<sup>st</sup> November)

In order to run this training we require a payment for the hiring of the pitch. This money will go towards covering the cost of hiring the pitches for training as well as matches. The cost for this will be £37 for the 3 terms. If you would like to pay term by term the cost will be £15 per term. In order to attend the training sessions this must be paid via Wise Pay in advance.

With regards to transport, there will be 2 minibuses travelling up to Polo Farm from school. There will only be 32 spaces in the first run and the other pupils will have to wait for the mini bus to get to Polo Farm and back again which can take quite a while. With this in mind we recommend where possible that parents give lifts from school up to Polo to allow maximum training time. It may be there are a group of parents who can get together and share and rotate this responsibility for a group of students.
