The production is set in Georgian England based on the historical evidence surrounding the periods of illness King George III suffered during his reign. It is a fast paced and often very entertaining play and also provides context knowledge for the A level set text, *Our Country's Good*.

The Madness of George III will be broadcast live to cinemas, in National Theatre Live's first ever broadcast from Nottingham Playhouse.

We will be meeting at the Gulbenkian Theatre in the foyer at 6.45pm. The finishing time is at 10.30pm.
