The Drama and Theatre Studies Department has booked tickets for the production **“War Horse”**, **7.30pm on Wednesday 13th March, 2019 at the Marlowe Theatre.**

‘War Horse’ The National Theatre’s acclaimed play, based on Michael Morpurgo’s novel.

At the outbreak of World War One, Joey, young Albert’s beloved horse, is sold to the Cavalry and shipped to France. He’s soon caught up in enemy fire, and fate takes him on an extraordinary journey, serving on both sides before finding himself alone in no man’s land. Albert, who remained on his parents’ Devon farm, cannot forget Joey. Though still not old enough to enlist he embarks on a treacherous mission to find him and bring him home.

We will meet in the foyer at the Marlowe Theatre at 7.00pm to be registered in groups. Students will need to be collected from the foyer at approximately 10:15pm and are not permitted to leave the foyer on their own for safety. To reserve a ticket for ‘War Horse’ please make payment via Wisepay and return the reply slip to the Drama office in A1. There are limited tickets so swift payment is advised to secure a place.

We are unable to make a charge for this visit by law, but the visit could not go ahead without sufficient funds and so the voluntary contribution for this visit will be £17.
